Where will PSE build Energize Eastside?

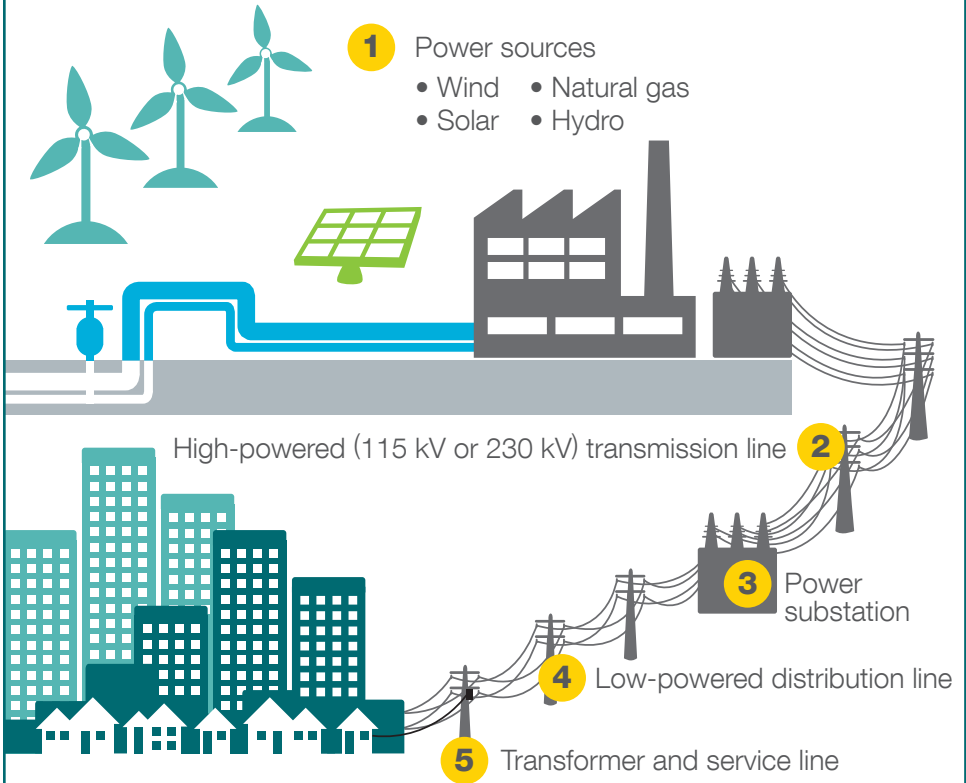
We selected the existing utility corridor as the final route for Energize Eastside. We chose this route because it is safe and is better for the environment.

What will Energize Eastside do?

PSE looked at several options to make sure the Eastside has stable power. Energize Eastside is the best way to solve the problem. Energize Eastside will build a new substation, replace the existing transmission lines, and continue meeting our aggressive conservation goals. A transmission line is a group of wires on tall poles that can move power from one place to another. The new lines will bring more power to the cities of Bellevue, Kirkland, Newcastle, Redmond and Renton.
