## How can neighborhoods learn more about the Energize Eastside project?

#### Open house



An open house is an opportunity for the public to learn more about the Energize Eastside project and have their questions answered in a casual setting. During an open house, you can chat with PSE staff at information stations sorted by key topics like project need, timeline, and route options.

If you have more specific questions about a route segment or potential effects to your neighborhood, you may find that a neighborhood briefing or neighborhood walkthrough better fits your needs.

### Neighborhood briefing



A neighborhood briefing is a presentation by a PSE representative that provides a general overview of the project, and covers the "who, what, where, when, and why" of Energize Eastside. These briefings are tailored to each neighborhood and are a great opportunity for you to provide input on the route selection process. Each briefing is followed by a question and answer period, and PSE representatives are on hand to collect your feedback and discuss your concerns. Briefings are typically held during a previously planned neighborhood event, such as a recurring homeowner's association meeting.

For neighborhoods seeking detailed information on potential project impacts, a neighborhood walkthrough may be more appropriate.

## Neighborhood walkthrough



A neighborhood walkthrough focuses on a single neighborhood and the nearby route segments. During a walkthrough, residents will walk along a proposed route segment with Energize Eastside staff. This is a great opportunity to ask specific questions regarding design, engineering, neighborhood characteristics, and construction along the segment. Final engineering may differ and will not occur until a final route has been selected.

Unlike neighborhood briefings, there are no formal presentations at a neighborhood walkthrough. This creates the opportunity for organic dialogue and idea exchange among all participants.
