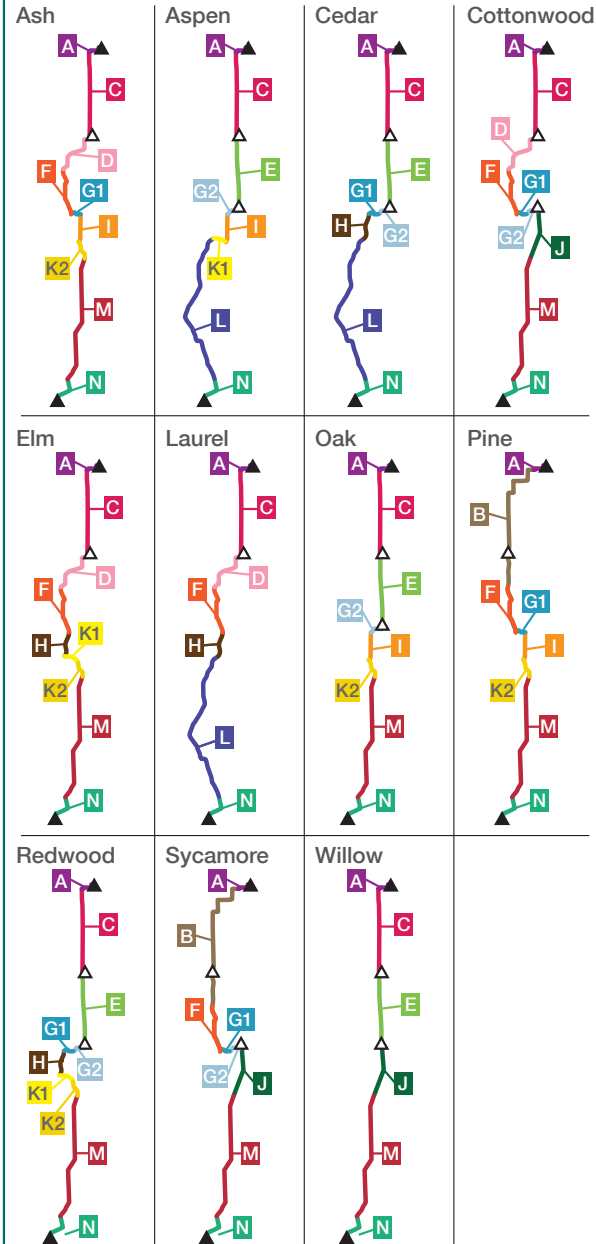

POTENTIAL ROUTE SEGMENTS



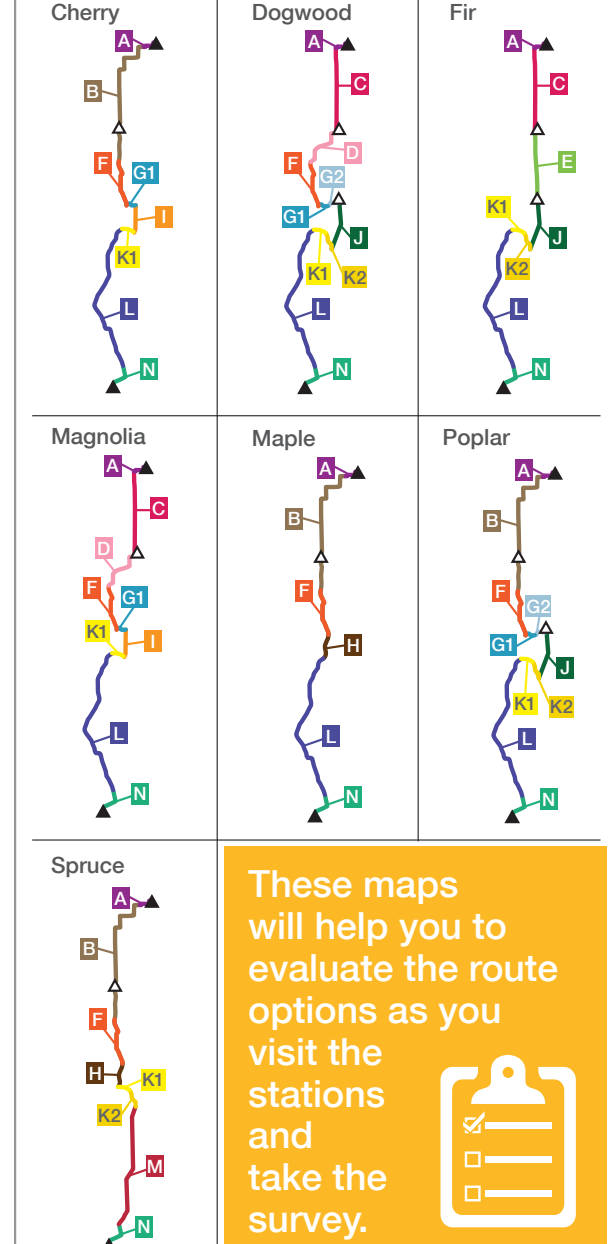
ROUTE OPTIONS RECOMMENDED for further evaluation by the Community Advisory Group
