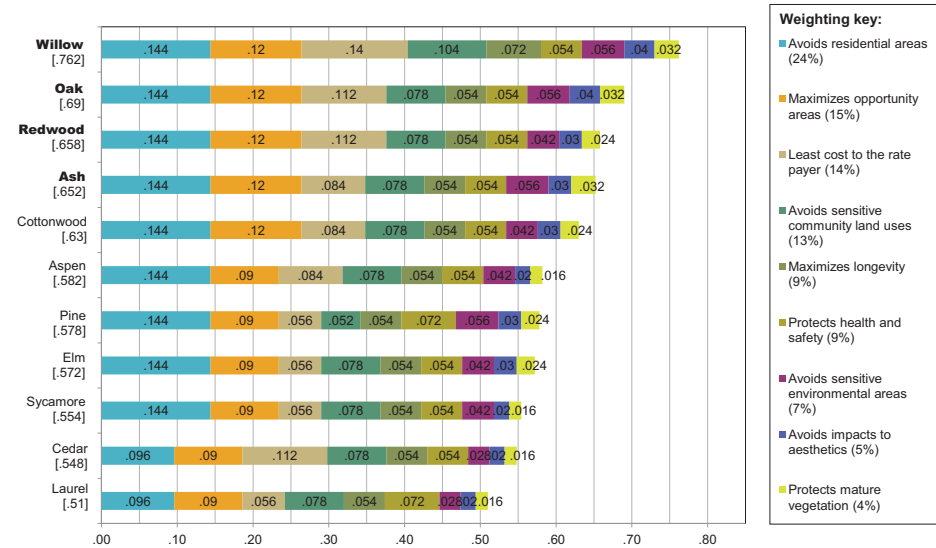


Results of the Multi-Objective Decision Analysis (MODA)

The Community Advisory Group decided to conduct the Multi-Objective Decision Analysis (MODA) evaluation using two sets of evaluation factor weightings – one determined by the advisory group and another by the summer community survey.

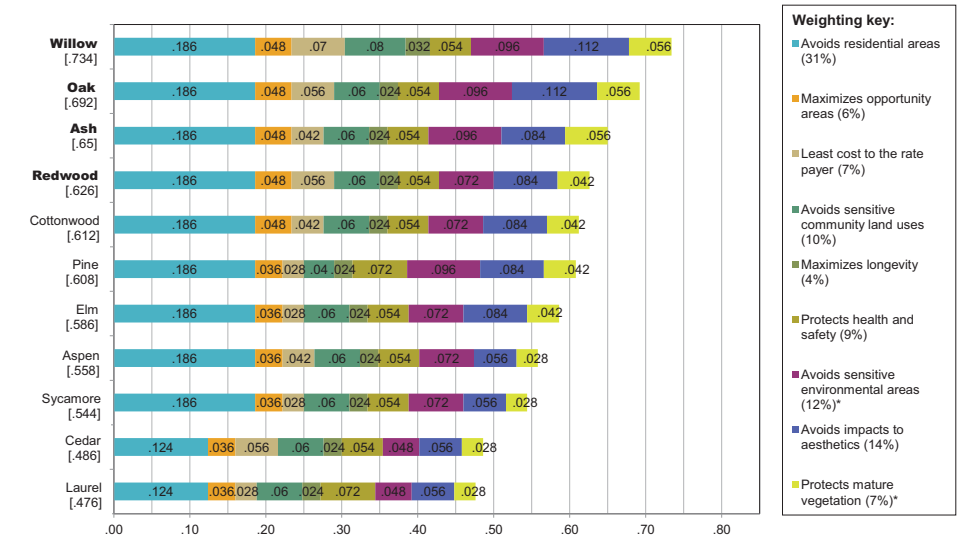
Advisory group weighting

The figure below shows the advisory group's overall MODA evaluation results using the advisory group weighted values.



Community survey weighting

The figure below shows the advisory group's overall MODA evaluation results using the community survey weighted values.



*Note: Transparent Choice, the online MODA software used to compile and calculate results, can only use weighting values that are whole numbers. As a result, the evaluation factors "Avoids sensitive environmental areas" and "Protects mature vegetation" were rounded to the nearest whole number.

What did the Community Advisory Group do with the MODA results?

- Reviewed and discussed both sets of results
- Conducted a sensitivity analysis, or “gut check,” of the results to ensure they matched the group’s values
- Considered these results and other sources of information—including additional community feedback—to determine their preliminary route recommendation
